

MWH Commissioned for Hydroelectric Power, Feasibility and Conceptual Design by Scottish Water

MWH has been commissioned by Scottish Water to carry out feasibility and conceptual design for 31 hydropower schemes across existing assets.

The project will involve up to 10 people at various stages during the 3 month delivery period. In addition to MWH's hydropower expertise, the team will be drawing on the knowledge and skills of our civil, electrical and mechanical engineers as well as environmental scientists, hydrologists and geologists.
